How do you find out if your child is eligible for the 30hrs of funding?

You will need to visit the following government website:

www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

Here you can find details relating to tax free childcare, tax credits for childcare, universal credit for childcare in addition to the funded hours. You will need to have your National Insurance number to hand when applying. If you are eligible you will be issued with an 11 digit eligibility code which you will need to provide to the nursery.

REMEMBER: You will need to re-apply every 3 months, you should receive an email reminder from HMRC so please ensure you check your junk mail too!
